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Chamber Legislative Priorities 2026

As the 2026 legislative session begins, the Chamber will focus on advocating for policies that support a strong business climate, workforce participation, and Greater Minnesota competitiveness. While many important issues will be considered this session, the priorities below represent the areas the Chamber will be most actively engaged in as we meet with legislators at the Capitol and monitor proposed legislation.

These priorities were developed with member and regional input, recommended to the Chamber Board of Directors, and formally approved to guide our advocacy efforts and ensure a consistent business voice.

2026 Legislative Priorities

- **Employer Mandate Reform** – Pursuing practical adjustments to workplace mandates to balance employee support with business sustainability.
- **Child Care Investment & Reform** – Expanding access to affordable, reliable child care while reducing unnecessary regulatory burdens so parents can work and providers can succeed.
- **K-12 & Higher Education Alignment** – Increasing local funding flexibility and strengthening career-connected learning to better align education with workforce needs.
- **Reducing Costs & Affordability** – Supporting policies that address the rising cost of doing business and living in Minnesota.
- **Health Care & Affordability** – Protecting access to quality, affordable health care in Greater Minnesota while addressing cost drivers.
- **Inclusive Access for Greater Minnesota** – Ensuring statewide policies and funding structures work effectively for rural communities.

These priorities will guide our conversations with legislators during the Chamber's Moorhead and Detroit Lakes Day at the Capital on March 11th and 12th and shape our advocacy efforts throughout the legislative session as proposals move forward.

She attended the Minnesota Chamber Legislative Priorities Dinner hosted by the Minnesota Chamber of Commerce, where business leaders and policymakers gathered to discuss priorities for the upcoming legislative session, with a focus on workforce, economic competitiveness, and a strong business climate for Minnesota.

Buboltz also attended the MCCE Winter Conference hosted by the Minnesota Chamber of Commerce Executives (MCCE), where she was honored with the **Rookie of the Year Award**.

This award recognizes a chamber executive with less than two years in the industry whose work goes above and beyond in service to their organization, community, and the chamber profession, while successfully navigating their first year and creating new opportunities for impact.

In addition, Buboltz graduated from the MCCE Executive Leadership Program, a multi-session experience hosted at chambers across the state that dives deep into core leadership areas through facilitation by leadership presenters, business and community leaders, and industry experts. Together, these experiences reflect the Chamber's commitment to strong leadership, continuous learning, and advocacy on behalf of the Detroit Lakes region.
